1. The Contractor is responsible for notifying all utilities in accordance with the Wisconsin Statutes 182.0175 (Call Diggers Hotline at 1-800-242-8511).
2. In the event that the installation allowed by this permit, at any time in the future, impedes or interferes with the widening or maintaining of the street or impedes or interferes with any City utility, as that utility now stands, as that utility may later be changed, or as that utility may be in need of repair or replacement, the City retains the right to require permittee to move or alter the installation otherwise allowed by this permit.
3. The permittee, by applying for and receiving a permit, shall be deemed to have agreed to be responsible for and save the City from any and all claims, resulting from damage or expense on account of injury to person or property caused by the permittee in the prosecution of the work done under such permit.
4. All obstructions, openings and other hazards shall be suitably guarded with barricades and lights to protect the public. No street or walk shall be blocked unless special permission in writing is granted by the City Engineer or his representative. No driveway shall be blocked, unless permission is granted by an occupant of the property served by the private driveway. In case permission is granted to block a street, the permittee shall notify the Police and Fire Departments prior to actually blocking the street.

STREET OPENING PERMIT FORM CONTINUED

- 5. The applicant shall comply with State Law in restoring sidewalks at intersections, i.e., curb ramps, etc.**

- 6. All damages to roadways or sidewalks shall be permanently repaired with like adjacent materials. All concrete street and concrete base repairs shall require the installation of 12” #6 or 24” #4 epoxy coated tie bars in accordance with WDOT Highways Specifications, Section 415.7.9 and spaced at 3 ft. on-center. Trenches through roadways, shall be backfilled with slurry backfill. Parkways shall be restored to the satisfaction of the adjacent property owner.**
