Re: Garbage and Recycling Collection

Dear Resident:

I am writing to discuss how the City plans on improving the garbage and recycling collection at your household.

Beginning Monday, September 20, 2021, the new City of Port Washington garbage and recycling collection provider will be Harter's Lakeside Disposal, LLC. Harter's will begin collecting garbage on that Monday using the same green garbage carts that you are using now. The garbage and recycling schedule will be staying the same (hours and days) until Monday, November 1, 2021. At that time, the City will switch to Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday collection. To be clear, this means the existing Friday collection route will switch to Thursday. The City will only be collecting garbage and recycling on Friday when there is a Holiday earlier in the week.

Also, beginning on Wednesday, October 6, 2021, new garbage and recycling carts will be delivered to your household, and the existing ones will be taken away. The existing carts will be picked up and the new carts will be dropped off at the end of your driveway (street or alley) on your normal collection day. Harter's will provide information hangers on the new carts regarding garbage and recycling pick up, a 2021 and 2022 garbage and recycling calendar, and a brochure on curbside recycling guidelines. All residents will be using carts once the new carts are delivered, and collection will occur at your driveway/alley approach to your garage and/or parking pad. Once the new carts are delivered, bagged garbage and recycling will no longer be picked up.

The City contract is for collection of garbage/recycling from residences only, and will not collect from businesses, churches, schools, apartments, and manufacturers/industries.
