

**CITY OF PORT WASHINGTON  
BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS  
MINUTES  
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 12, 2010**

**ROLL CALL:** Vice-Chairman Jim Vollmar called the City of Port Washington Board of Public Works meeting to order at 5:05 p.m. in the Lower Level Conference room at the City Hall. Members present: Alderman Mike Ehrlich, Alderman Paul Neumyer, Board Member Peter Hermann, and Board Member Kevin Rudser. Also present were: Water Supt./Commissioner Dave Ewig, City Administrator Mark Grams and City Engineer Vanden Noven. Absent and excused: Wastewater Supt. Dan Buehler and Craig Czarnecki.

**Chairman's Business:** There was none.

**MOTION BY PETER HERMANN AND SECONDED BY ALDERMAN MIKE EHRLICH to approve the minutes from August 10, 2010. Motion carried unanimously.**

**New Business:**

**A. ROAD TOUR OF CITY STREETS:** City Engineer Vanden Noven reviewed City streets with the Board Members on a riding tour of the City.

**Project Updates:**

**a. SOUTH WISCONSIN STREET (WE ENERGIES):** City Engineer Vanden Noven stated that the street will be open on Wednesday, October 20, 2010. The City and WE Energies will have a ribbon cutting ceremony at 9:00 a.m. at the intersection of Chestnut and Wisconsin.

**b. 2010 STREET IMPROVEMENTS (DIVISION/CHESTNUT/WISCONSIN):** City Engineer Vanden Noven stated that Chestnut and Division Street are open for traffic. This project is completed.

**c. Portview Drive:** City Engineer Vanden Noven stated the project is on schedule and will be paved next week.

**d. North Lake Street Public Information Meeting:** City Engineer Vanden Noven stated that a public information meeting on North Lake Street will be held on Tuesday, October 19<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m. This meeting will allow the property owners on North Lake Street to review the new design and to receive input from the owners.

**Forthcoming Events:** Alderman Vollmar questioned why the garbage is not picked up from alleys. City Engineer Vanden Noven informed him that the decision was made over a decade ago that the trucks are damaging the alleys and the alleys are too narrow for the trucks to operate. Alderman Vollmar wanted to remind everyone that the League of Wisconsin Municipalities meeting is being held this weekend. Alderman Vollmar also questioned what the City is doing about the weeds in cracks between the curb flange and the street. Street Commissioners Ewig is looking into it.
