ORDINANCE NO. 2020-6**

**Repealing 2-Hour Parking Restrictions on Portions of
West Oakland Avenue between South Park Street and Keeney Avenue**

**Repealing the Yield Right-of-Way Intersection Designation for
North Benjamin Street at Its Intersection with West Jefferson Street**

**Providing for the Installation of an Official Stop Sign
on North Benjamin Street at Its Intersection with West Jefferson Street**

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Committee of the City of Port Washington has recommended that the Common Council adopt ordinances providing for: the repeal of 2-hour parking limits on certain portions of a City street; the repeal of a yield right-of-way requirement at the intersection of certain City streets; and the installation of an official stop sign at said intersection, in order to control traffic and promote public safety within the City,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Port Washington, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Sections 8.05.010 E. 7. and E. 8. of the Municipal Code of the City of Port Washington, establishing 2-hour parking limits along certain portions of West Oakland Avenue between South Park Street and Keeney Avenue, are repealed.

Section 2. Section 8.05.060 1. of the Municipal Code of the City of Port Washington, designating North Benjamin Street at its intersection with West Jefferson Street as a yield right-of-way intersection, is repealed.

Section 3. Section 8.05.070 B. 299. of the Municipal Code of the City of Port Washington, relating to the installation of an official stop sign, is created to read as follows:

299. On North Benjamin Street where it intersects with West Jefferson Street.


Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
