

**CITY OF PORT WASHINGTON, WISCONSIN
ORDINANCE NO. 2021-16**

An Ordinance Establishing 15-Minute Parking Limits within a Portion of Municipal Lot C-4

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Committee of the City of Port Washington has recommended that the Common Council adopt an ordinance establishing a 15-minute time limit for three parking stalls within a portion of Municipal Lot C-4 for the purpose of allowing charter boat fishing customers to unload and load their vehicles during the City marina operating season,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Port Washington, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:


Section 1. Subsection 8.05.010 B. 16 of the Municipal Code, relating to 15-Minute Parking limits, is created to read as follows:

16. The three (3) southeasternmost parking spaces in the public parking lot bounded by East Grand Avenue on the south, East Main Street on the north, the west boundary of the North Slip on the east, and the east boundary lines of the properties at 100, 114, 122 and 128 North Franklin Street on the west (said lot also identified as Municipal Lot C-4 in Figure 1 of Section 8.05.030), for the exclusive use of charter boat fishing customers for the purpose of and while actually engaged in unloading or loading their vehicles between the hours of 4:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. from April 1 to October 31, inclusive.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
