

**CITY OF PORT WASHINGTON, WISCONSIN
ORDINANCE NO. 2021-17**

An Ordinance Amending Parking Restrictions on Portions of East Main Street

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Committee of the City of Port Washington has recommended that the Common Council adopt an ordinance prohibiting parking on portions of East Main Street, in order to promote public safety,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Port Washington, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Subsections 8.05.010 A. 139 and 140 of the Municipal Code, relating to No Parking areas, are amended to read as follows:

139. On the south side of East Main Street from the east curb line of North Franklin Street to a point 105 feet east thereof, and from a point 150 feet east of the east curb line of North Franklin Street around the curve of the cul-de-sac to the point where the curve meets the north curb line of East Main Street, tangent to the cul-de-sac.
140. On the north side of East Main Street from the first driveway east of the east curb line of North Franklin Street easterly to the point where the north curb line of East Main Street meets the curve of the cul-de-sac, tangent to the cul-de-sac.


Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
