

**CITY OF PORT WASHINGTON, WISCONSIN
ORDINANCE NO. 2021-19**

**An Ordinance Amending Certain Municipal Code Provisions Relating to
Decreased Speed Limits and Decreasing the Speed Limit within Coal Dock Park**

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Committee of the City of Port Washington has recommended that the Common Council adopt an ordinance decreasing the speed limit for motor vehicles operated within Coal Dock Park from 20 miles per hour to 15 miles per hour since such speed limit is a reasonable and safe speed limit, and will promote public safety,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Port Washington, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 8.02.020 A. of the Municipal Code, relating to decreased speed limits on certain streets or portions thereof within the City of Port Washington, is amended to read as follows:

- A. 15 miles per hour, pursuant to sec. 346.57(4)(a), Wis. Stat., on the following highways and streets within the City of Port Washington:
1. On North Wisconsin Street from Beutel Road north to the entrance to the parking lot of St. John XXIII Catholic Church and School - St. Peter of Alcantara Church site.
 2. On North Freeman Drive from Grand Avenue north to the entrance to the parking lot of St. John's Lutheran Church and Academy.


Section 2. Subsection 14.02.020 3. of the Municipal Code, relating to unlawful conduct in any city park or upon any public grounds within the City of Port Washington, is amended to read as follows:

3. Operate any motor vehicle upon any roadway or portion thereof at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour, except that the speed limit for motor vehicles operated within Coal Dock Park shall be 15 miles per hour. Pursuant to sec. 346.57(5), Wis. Stat., official traffic signs shall be posted giving notice of such zoned speed limits.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
