

Brush collection

Reminder that the last week of brush collection is the week of **October 19th**. Brush must be out by **7 a.m. on Monday, October 19, 2020** to be collected for that week.

Brush collection is for tree trimming and small removals (8" diameter or less.) Large tree removals and large quantities of brush need to be removed by a private contractor.

Please stack brush in neat individual piles for easier pickup with the cut ends pointing in the direction of traffic. Please do not make one large pile with branches stacked in all different directions.

Trimmings less than 1' in length need to be placed in a pail, garbage can, or some sort of container for easier pick up. The city is not responsible for brush on vacant lots.

Leaf pickup

Leaf pickup begins October 5th

Residents may begin raking leaves into the streets beginning **Monday, October 5, 2020** and can continue raking until Sunday, November 29, 2020 **weather permitting**. Leaves can also be bagged and brought down to the Municipal Yard, 333 North Moore Road, until Saturday, December 5, 2020. **The yard is open on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3 pm to 6 pm and Saturdays from 10 am to 4 pm.**

Residents should not place branches, brush, plotted plants, or grass clippings into the gutter with leaves. These items clog the sweeper trucks and cause downtime. Piles with these items will not be picked up by city crews.
